The California State University Connectivity Contributing to Equity and Student Success (CSUCCESS) program provides first-time freshmen and new transfer students entering CSUN during the fall 2021 term with a new iPad for the duration of their undergraduate education at CSUN.



What do students receive for free?

- 64 GB iPad Air
- Apple Smart Keyboard Folio
- Apple Pencil
- Student technology support from CSUN

How do I register for the CSUCCESS program?

To receive your equipment, you must first register for the program. Registration is quick and can be completed online. To register, log in to the myNorthridge Portal and navigate to the Services tab, and select the CSUCCESS Program link.

Where can I pick up my iPad?

Devices can be picked up at the CSUN Campus Store. After you have registered for the program, you will receive an email notification when your equipment is ready for pick-up.

What can I do if I don't have access to the internet?

The iPads are Wi-Fi only models and are not equipped with cellular data service. If you do not have internet connectivity, as a student, you have access to internet hotspots and other loaner technology devices through the CSUN Device Loaner Program.

The CSUCCESS program is part of CSUN's commitment to assuring every student has access to reliable, high quality computing devices.
