**RESOLUTION ON THE ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION
OF COURSEWORK**

(Approved by the Faculty Senate, May 8, 2014)

WHEREAS, the Campus Sustainability Plan calls for reduced printing across campus; and

WHEREAS, an Ad Hoc Committee on Lab Printing has presented recommendations, accepted by the Provost's Council, to provide access to printing in Academic Affairs computer labs, with a default of duplex (two-sided) printing and a uniform printing quota for students; therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the Faculty Senate join the Academic Technology Committee and the Educational Resources Committee in recommending that, at the discretion of the individual instructor, faculty allow students to submit papers and other assignments electronically (e.g. email, learning management system); and be it further

RESOLVED: that the Faculty Technology Center continue to offer support and specific instruction to faculty who wish to become more proficient in electronic grading of submitted papers and other assignments. The Senate encourages the allocation of resources (including reassigned time) in support of faculty who seek such instruction.
