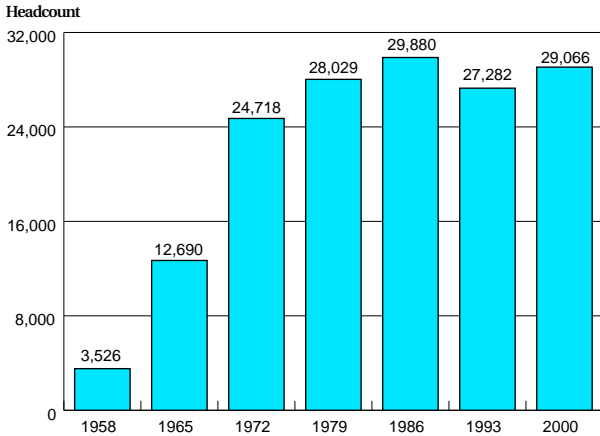

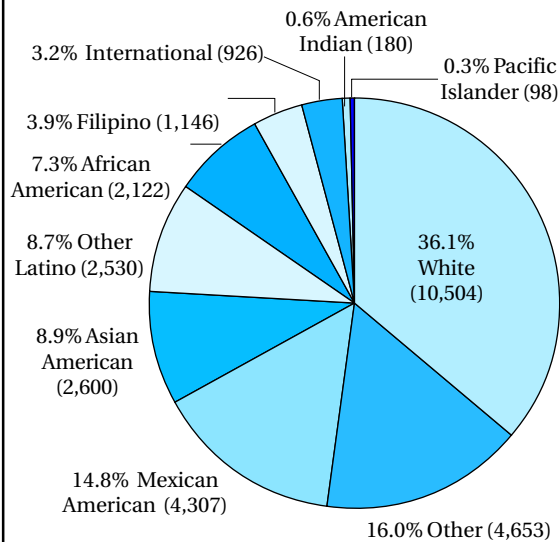

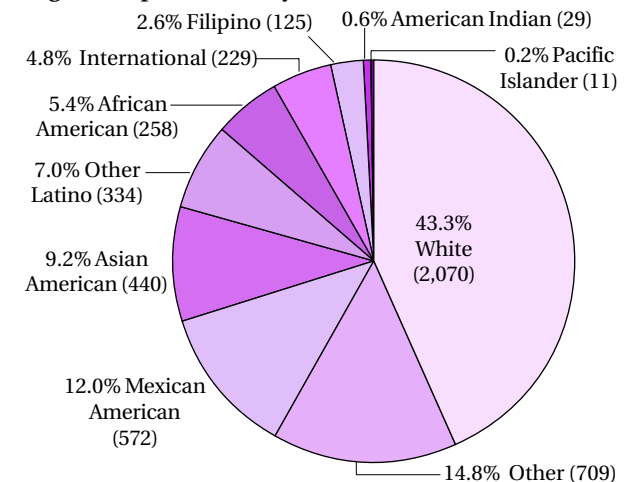

### Degree Recipient Ethnicity



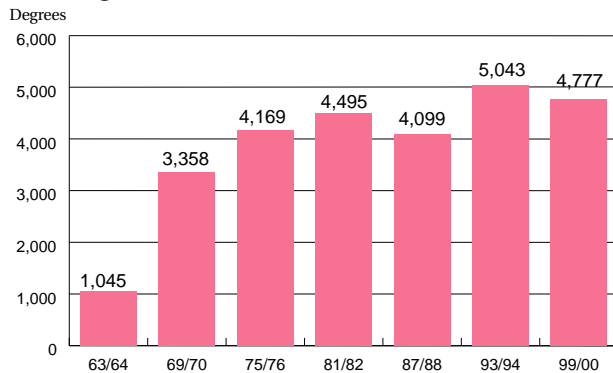

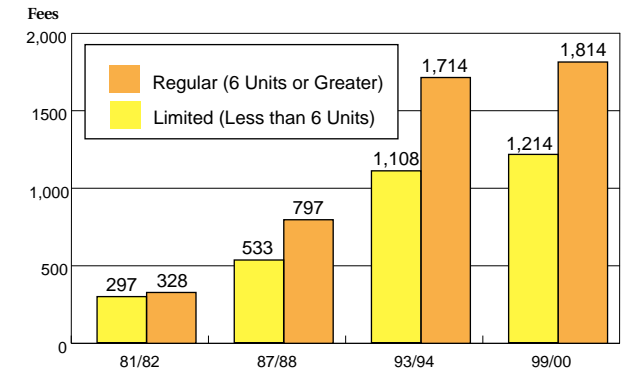

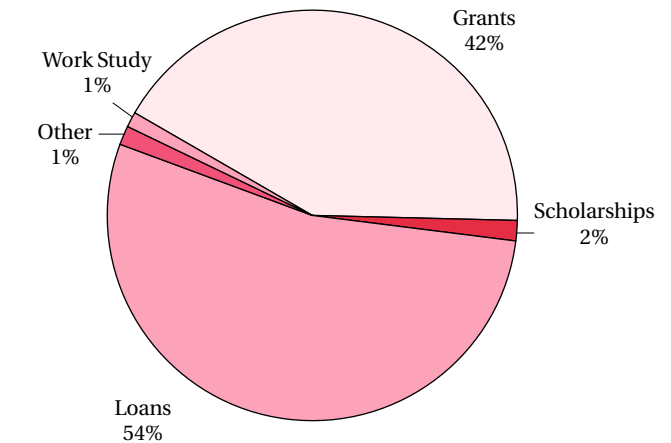
### Undergraduate Resident Tuition & Fee History
