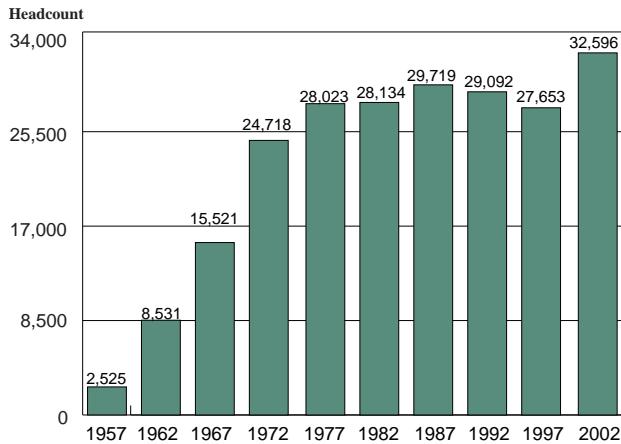

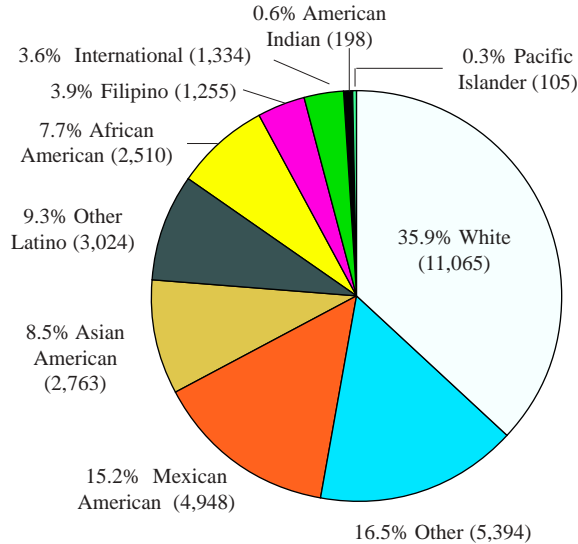

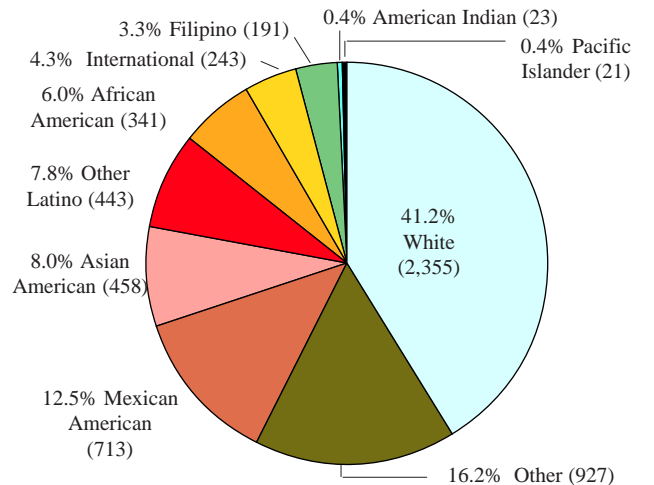

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



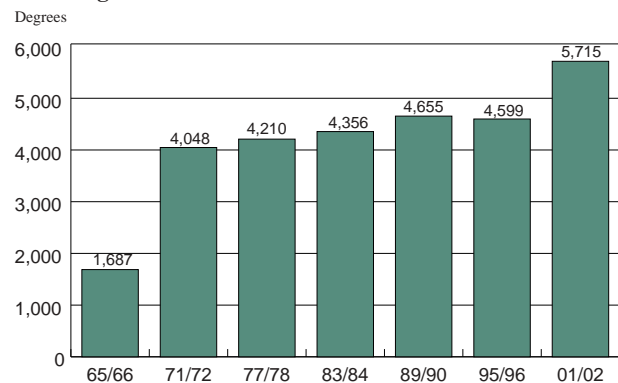

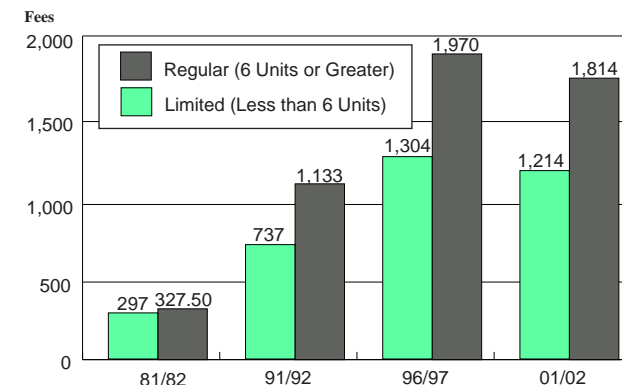

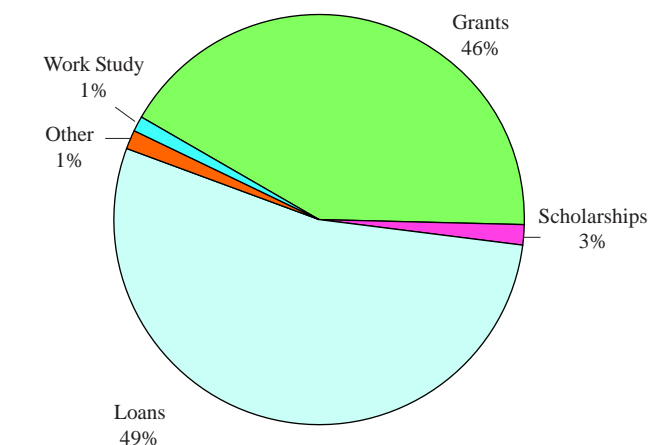
Undergraduate Resident Tuition & Fee History
