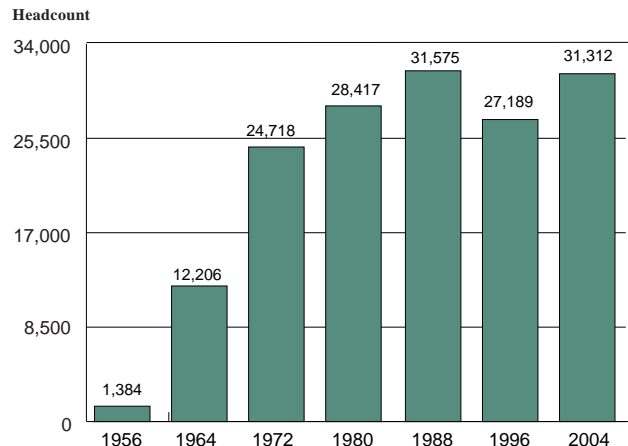

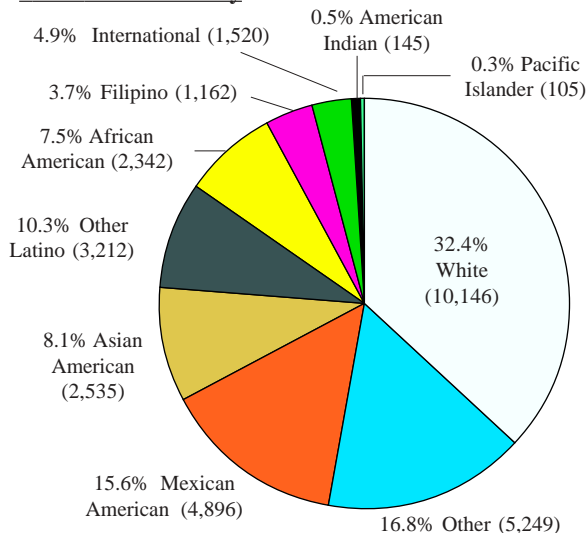

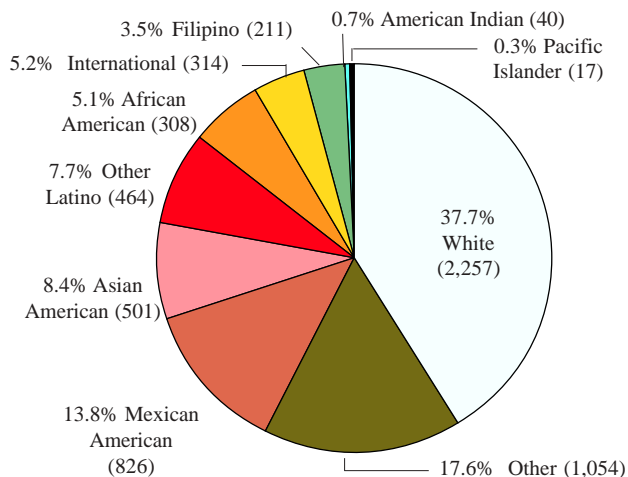

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



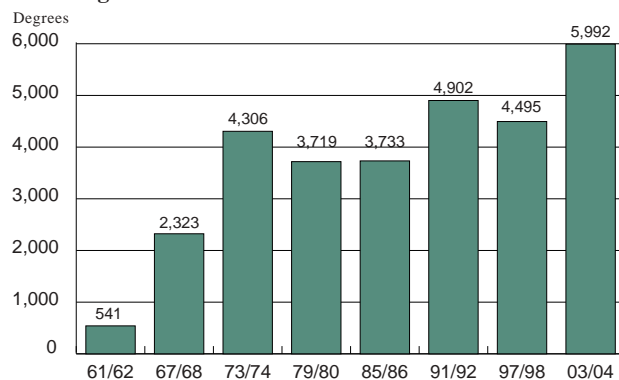

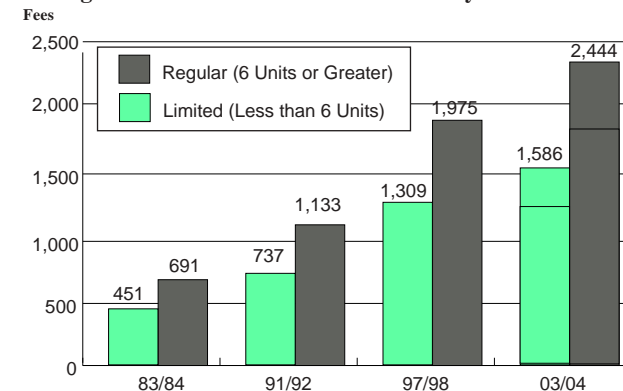

Tuition & Financial Aid 2003/04

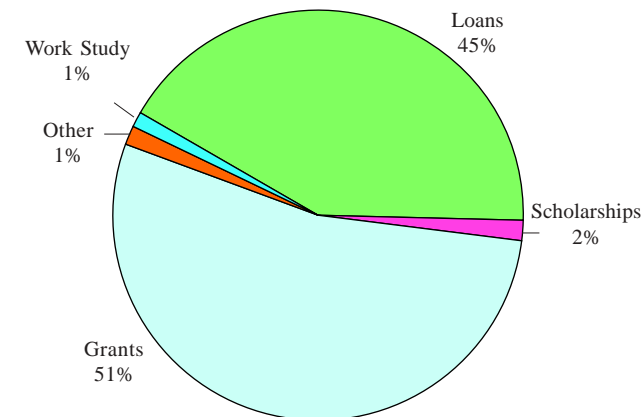
Undergraduate Resident Tuition & Fee History
