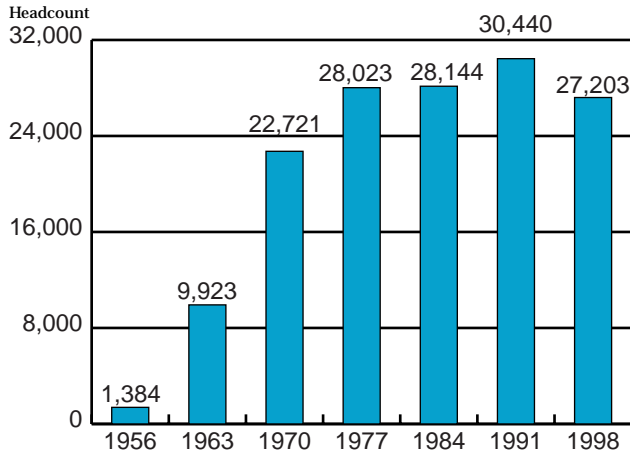

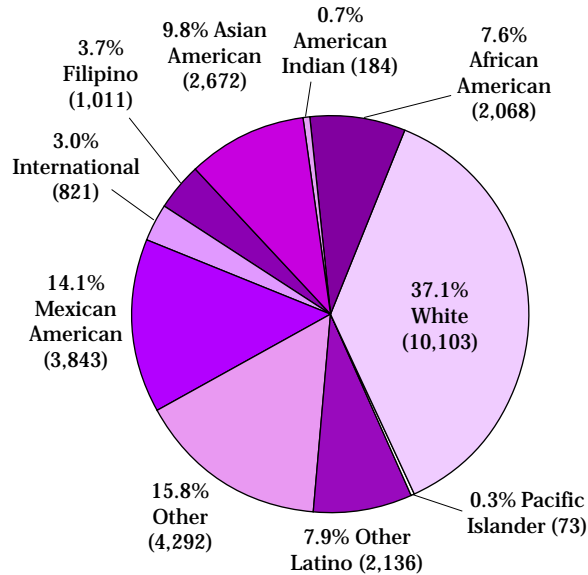

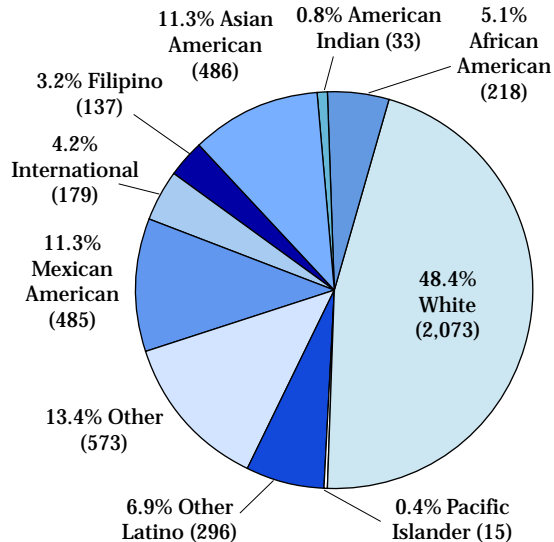

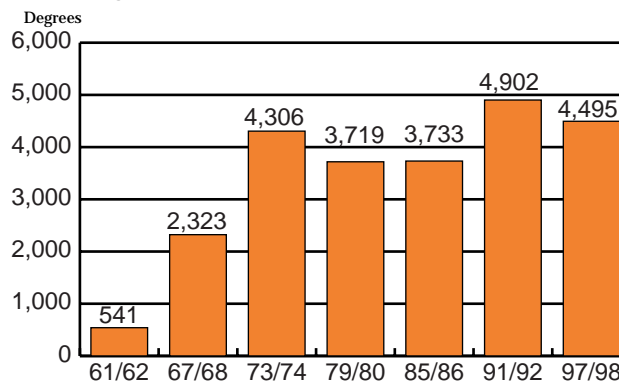

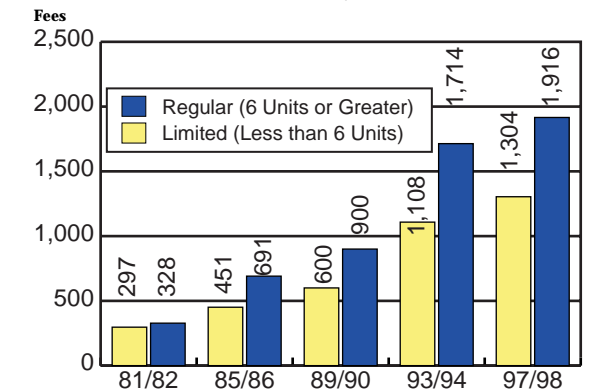
Total Degrees 1961/62 to 1997/98

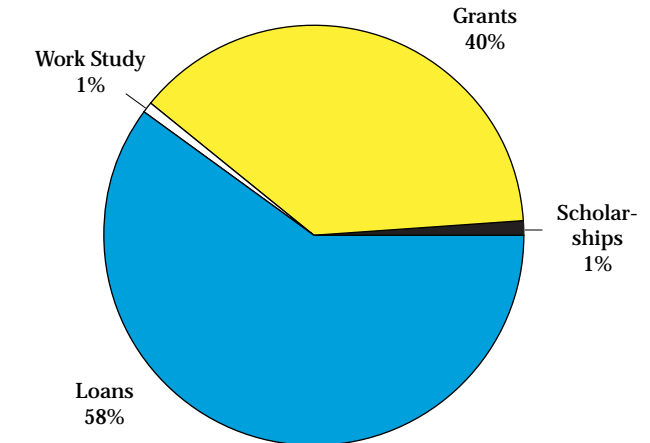
Resident Tuition & Fee History
