- 1 **IMPORTANT!** Reducing the number of enrolled units may affect your eligibility for **Campus Housing, International Student Status, Financial Aid**, and more. A Financial Aid student who reduces the number of units or who completely withdraws may be subject to REPAYMENT (including medical withdrawals). Before adjusting your schedule, review the **Information Regarding Change in Program or Schedule** at [www.csun.edu/ugs/academicprogramchanges.html](http://www.csun.edu/ugs/academicprogramchanges.html) and contact the appropriate office for guidance.
- 2 Students enrolled in PACE, accelerated and online courses must adhere to the same deadlines and procedures as those outlined in this table.
- 3 If units increase to 6.1 or more, additional fees and, if applicable, nonresident tuition will result. Check your account balance in the SOLAR Student Center. For payment information, see [University Cash Services](#).
- 4 The *4th Week Change of Schedule Request* can only be used Monday through Friday of Week 4 of instruction. It will NOT be accepted before or after this week.
- 5 To **swap** classes of equal unit value in Week 4, be sure to add and drop **at the same time** to avoid additional fees including nonresident tuition if applicable.
- 6 Withdrawals are not permitted during the last three weeks of instruction (i.e., November 17-December 9, 2009) or thereafter except when a newly occurring condition is evident.
