- 1 **IMPORTANT!** Reducing the number of enrolled units may affect your eligibility for **Campus Housing, International Student Status, Financial Aid**, and more. A Financial Aid student who reduces the number of units or who completely withdraws may be subject to **REPAYMENT** (including medical withdrawals). Before adjusting your schedule, review the **Information Regarding Change in Program or Schedule** at www.csun.edu/ugs/academicprogramchanges.html and contact the appropriate office for guidance.
- 2 Students enrolled in PACE, accelerated and online courses must adhere to the same deadlines and procedures as those outlined in this table.
- 3 If units increase to 6.1 or more, additional fees and, if applicable, nonresident tuition will result. Check your account balance in the SOLAR Student Center. For payment information, see University Cash Services.
- 4 The 4th Week Change of Schedule Request can only be used Monday through Friday of Week 4 of instruction. It will NOT be accepted before or after this week.
- 5 To **swap** classes of equal unit value in Week 4, be sure to add and drop **at the same time** to avoid additional fees, including nonresident tuition if applicable.
- 6 Withdrawals are not permitted during the last three weeks of instruction (i.e., November 16-December 8, 2010) or thereafter except when a newly occurring condition is evident.
