## Sexual Battery

**DATE/TIME:** Tuesday July 30, 2019 at 4:50pm

**LOCATION:** Public Bus –Saticoy/Reseda to  
CSUN Transit Center

### **REPORTED OFFENSE:**

The suspect boarded the bus and sat next to the victim. During the commute the suspect extended his elbow up along the right side of her rib and breast. The suspect followed the victim off the bus and continued to loiter in the area near the victim.

**SUSPECT DESCRIPTION PER VICTIM:** Male, Asian, 30 years old, wearing glasses with stubble, 5' 4", average build, wearing a light blue t-shirt, tan shorts, and wearing a lot of bracelets on each wrist.

**ADDITIONAL DESCRIPTION OBSERVED FROM CCTV CAMERA FOOTAGE:** On t-shirt there are white stripes on the shoulders and a white emblem on the left side of chest and has a dark colored backpack.

### **CRIME PREVENTION TIPS**

- If something makes you feel uncomfortable, trust your instincts, if you feel safe doing so say something or leave the area.
- Limit time in isolated areas whenever possible and seek highly populated areas.
- Be mindful of suspicious activity - If you observe suspicious activity or a crime in progress be a good witness and call the police immediately! Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. CSUN PD: (818) 677-2111.
- Dialing 911 while on campus will connect you to the University Police. You can also program the CSUN PD dispatch (818) 677-2111 into your cell phone for quick access when needed.
