

# CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE MATADORS

## PINWHEEL

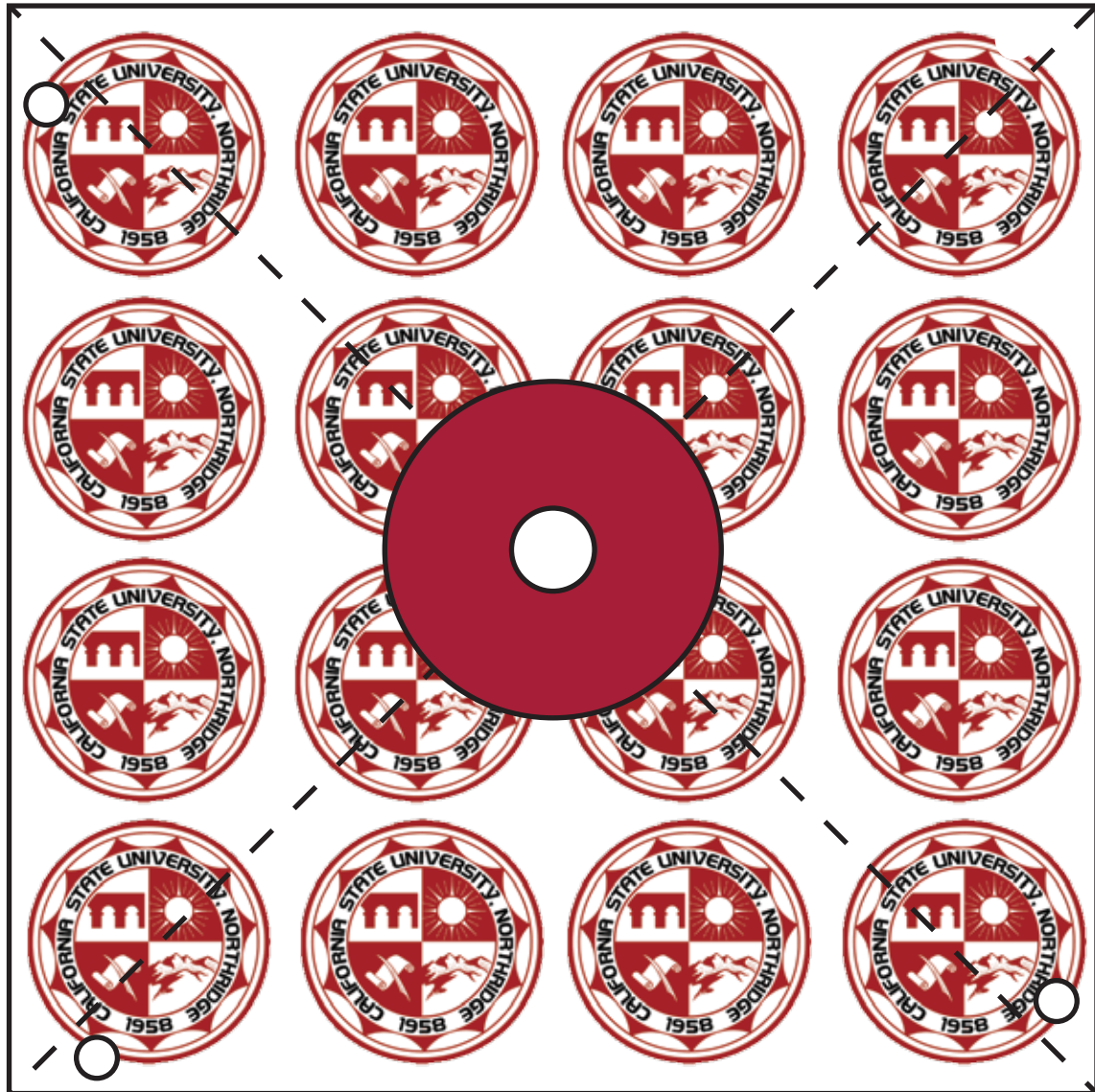

### YOU'LL NEED:

A plastic straw

A brad, which is a brass fastener or split pin

### STEPS:

1. Print and cut out the template (see Figure 1).
2. Punch holes in the corners and the center of the template.
3. Pull the corners to the back toward the center and line up the punched holes (see Figure 2).

4. Cut 1/8 inch off the straw. Insert the brad in to the straw.
5. Place the straw in to the pinwheel hole. Open the brad and secure the pinwheel.
6. Attach pinwheel to a thin dowel rod.

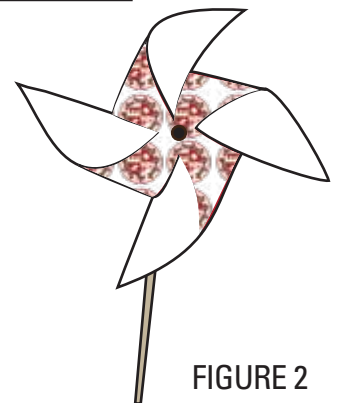
