
POLICY ON PLUS/MINUS GRADING. At its February 5, 1987 meeting, the Faculty Senate recommended approval of the following policy proposed by the Educational Policies Committee:

Beginning with the Fall 1987 semester and thereafter, plus/minus grading will be incorporated into the University's present grading system. The system to be adopted will be system #2 (A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, D-, F) as described in the report issued by the Subcommittee on Plus/Minus Grading of September 3, 1986.

This policy shall not be retroactive prior to Fall 1987 (No retroactive plus/minus grades for courses taken prior to Fall 1987 shall be assigned).

This policy shall be optional, but instructors shall inform their students of the system for their grading at the beginning of the semester, whether or not they will employ the plus/minus symbols.

I concur with the Senate's recommendation. The policy is approved for implementation with the Fall 1987 semester.
