

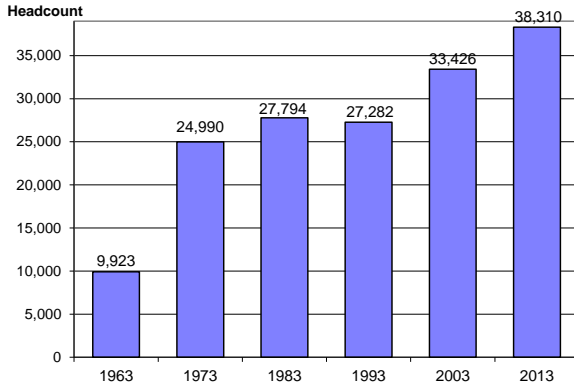

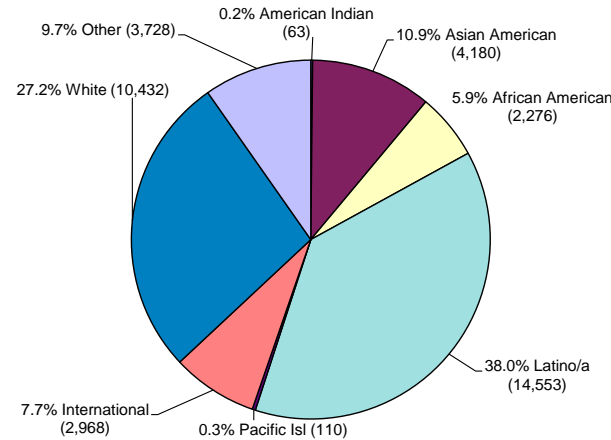

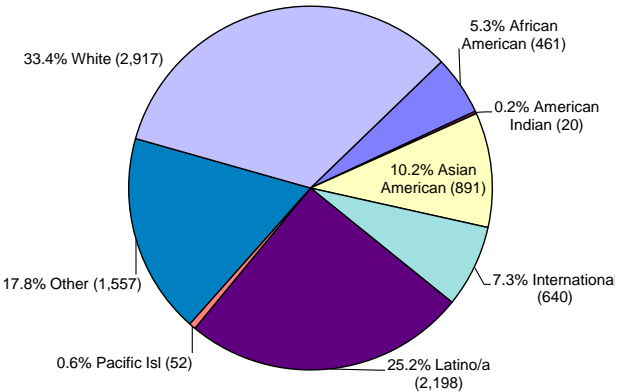

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



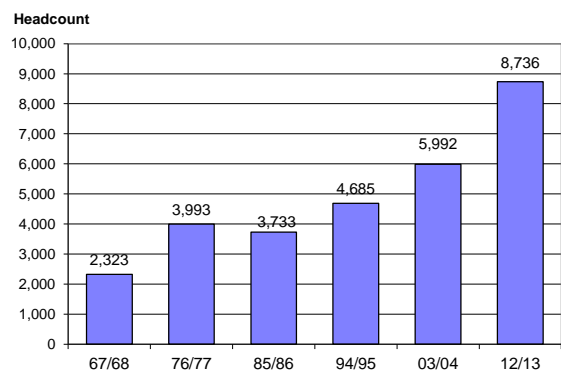

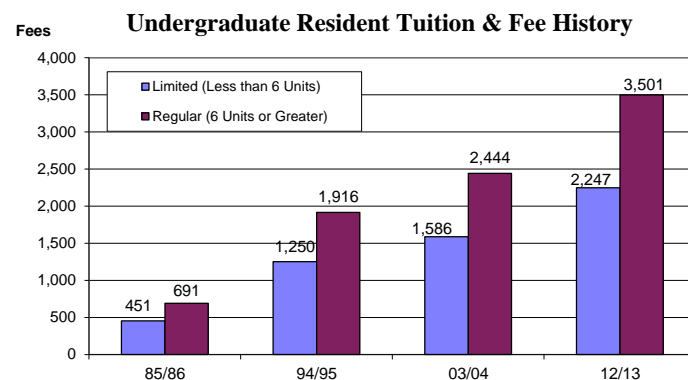

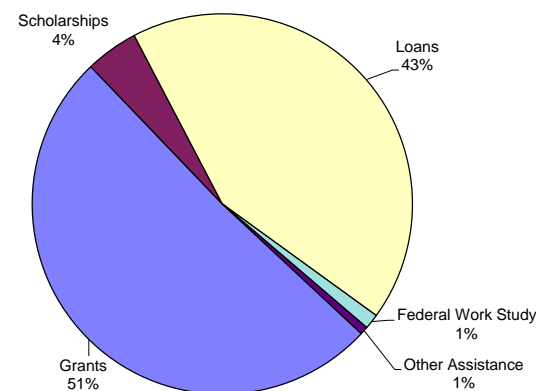
Tuition & Financial Aid 2012/13
