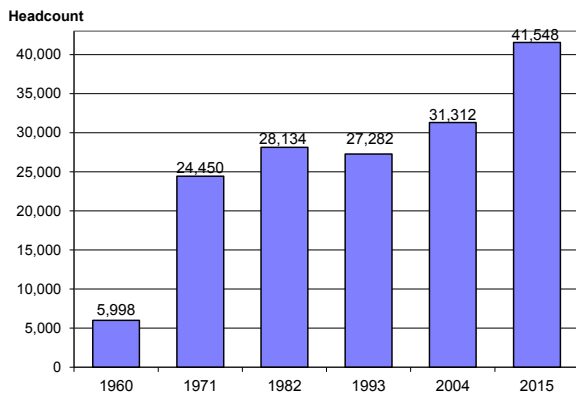

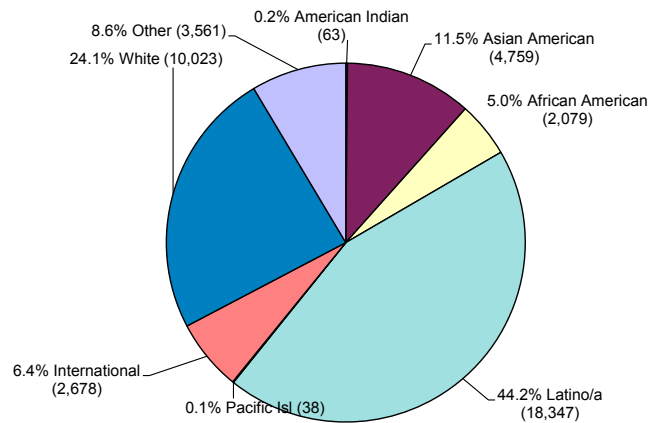

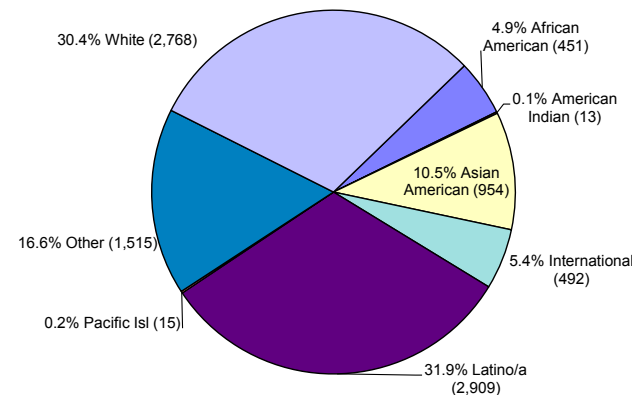

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



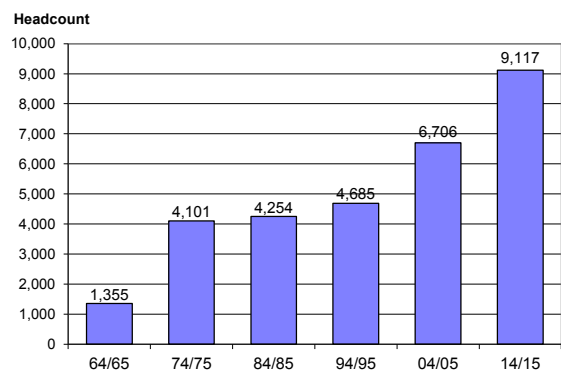

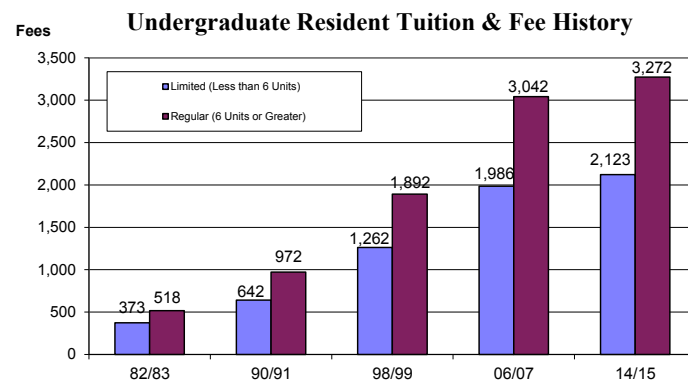

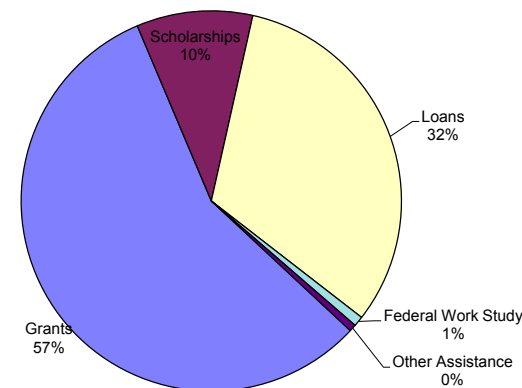
Tuition & Financial Aid 2014/15
