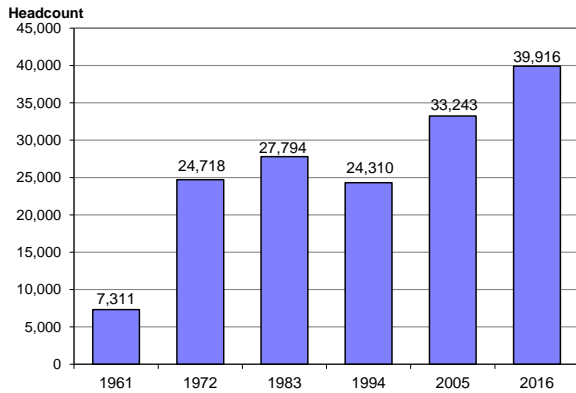

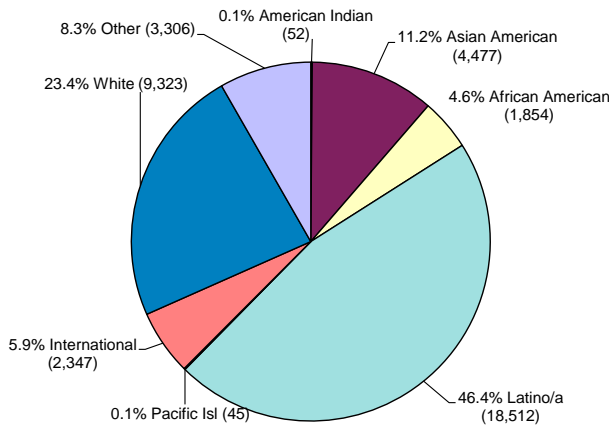

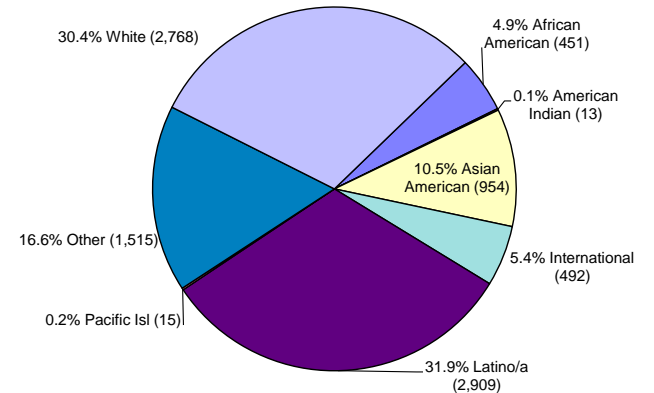

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



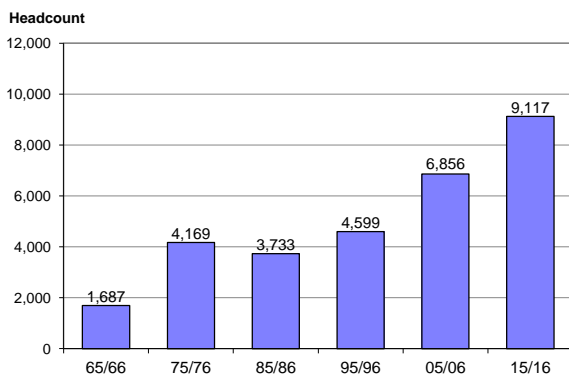

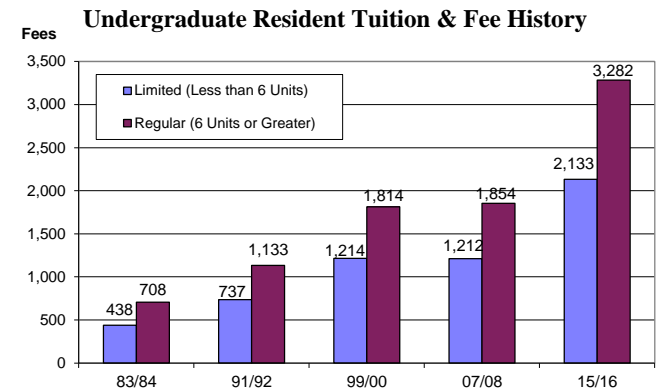

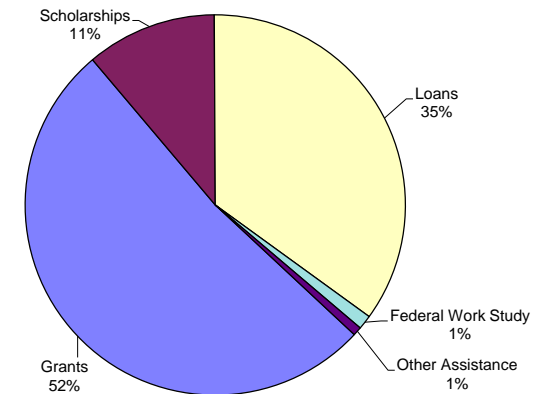
Tuition & Financial Aid 2015/16
