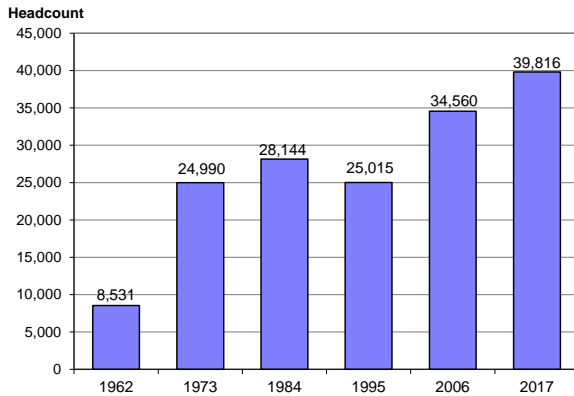

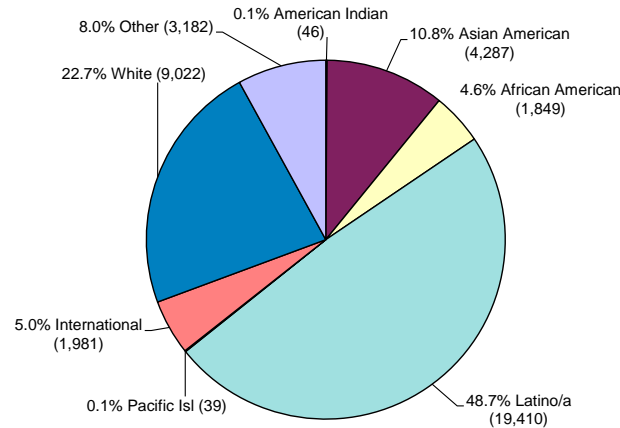

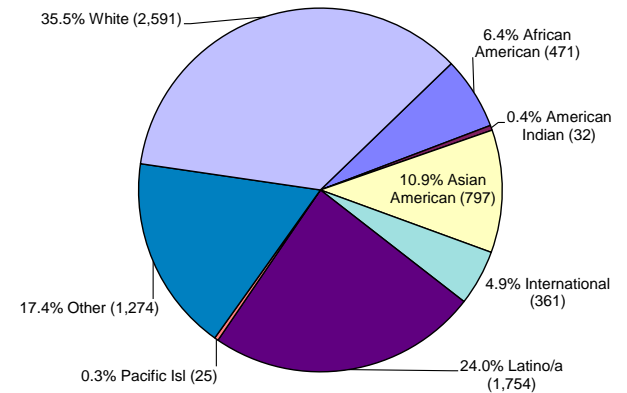

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



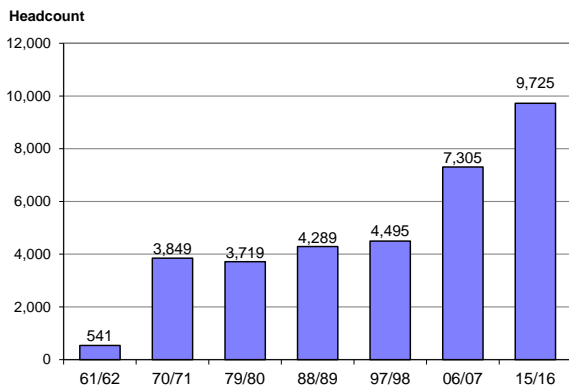

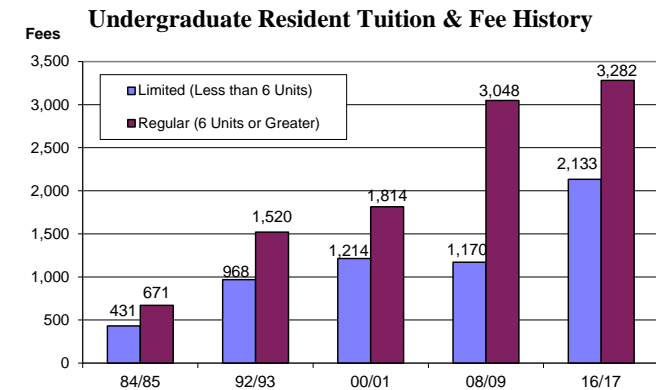

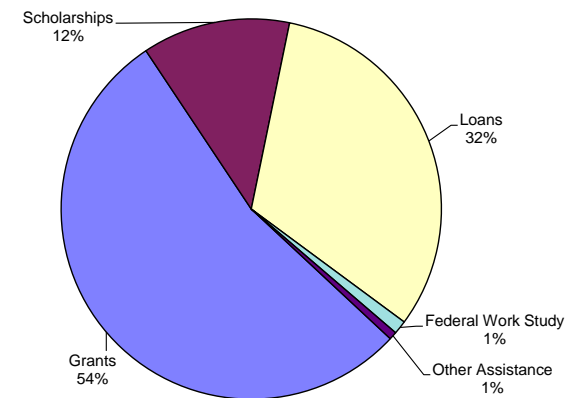
Tuition & Financial Aid 2016/17
