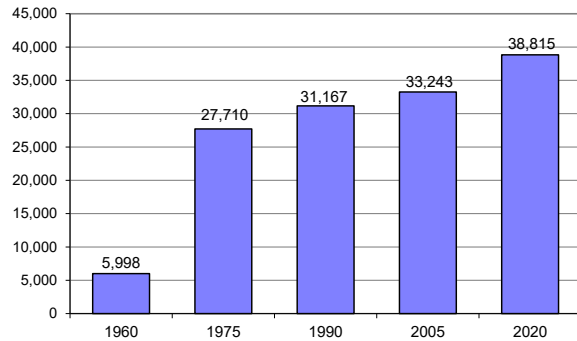

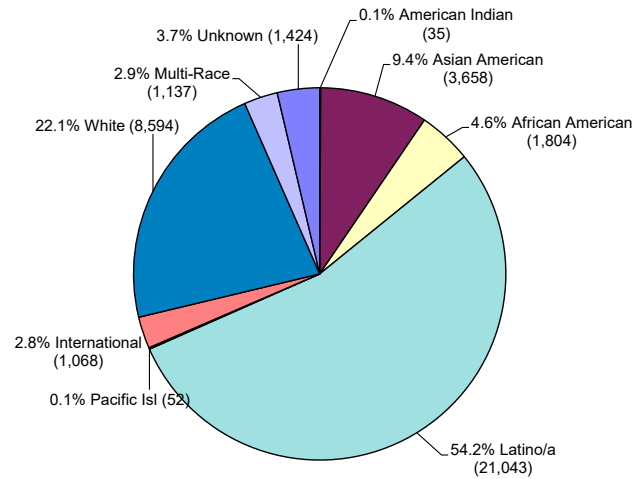

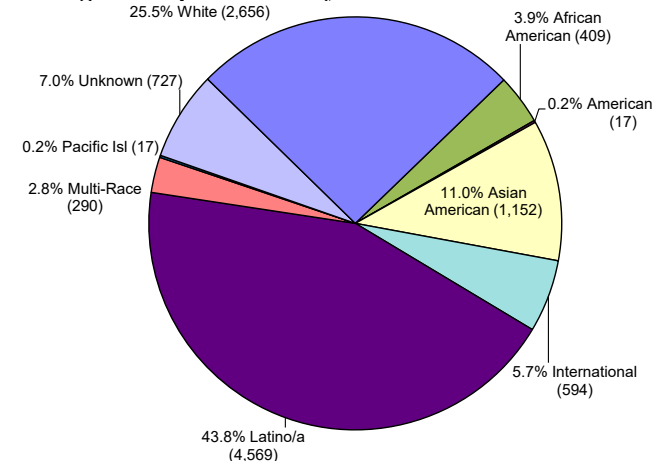

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



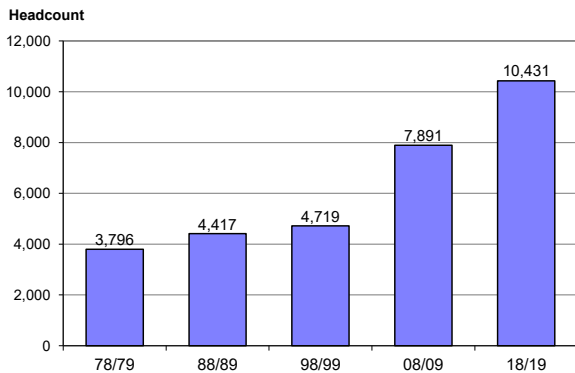

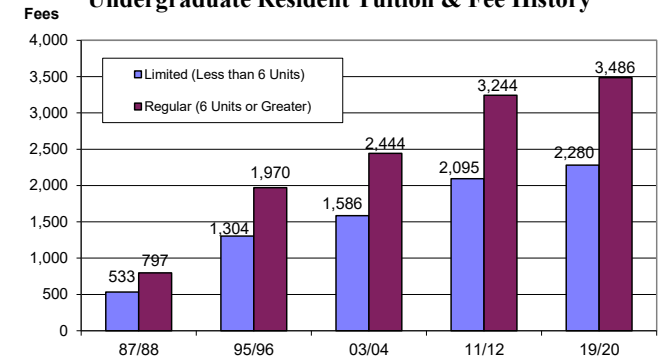

Tuition & Financial Aid 2019/20

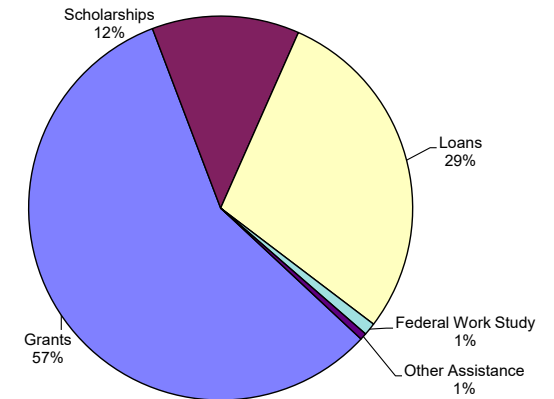
Undergraduate Resident Tuition & Fee History
