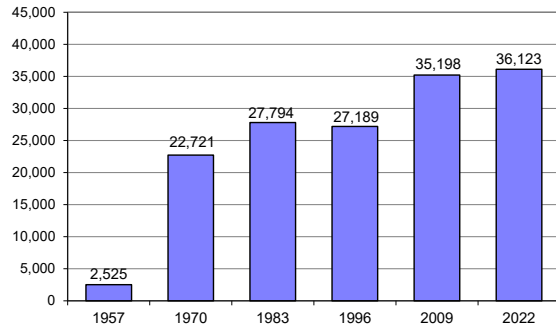

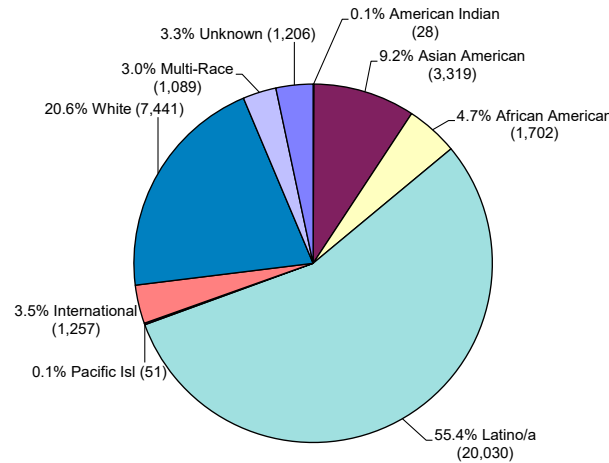

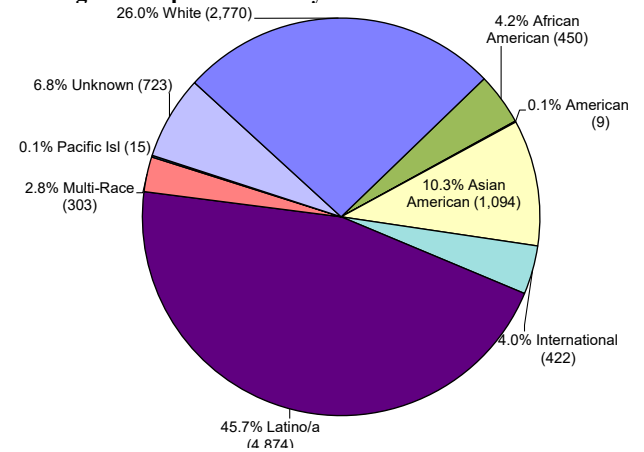

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



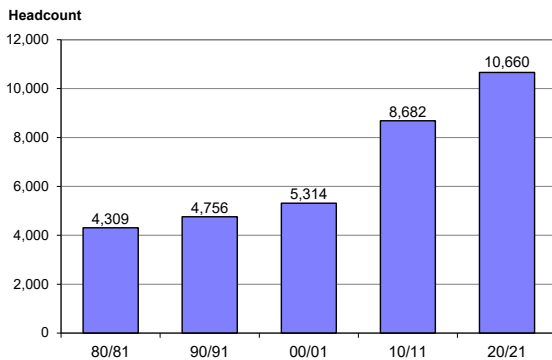

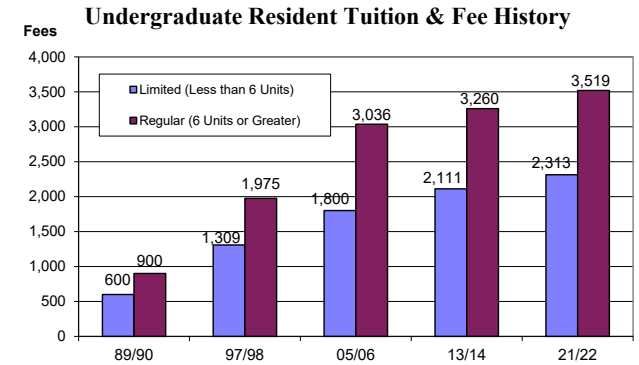

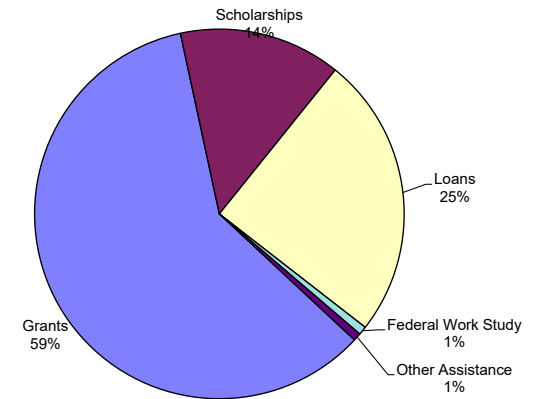
Tuition & Financial Aid 2021/22
