FINAL EXAMINATION POLICY

Student achievement shall be evaluated in all courses. Students shall be fully informed of the manner of their evaluation as well as the requirements and assignments at the start of each semester. In lecture courses, no final examination may be scheduled by an instructor prior to the regularly scheduled time. Any student who finds it impossible to take a final examination on the date scheduled must make arrangements in advance with the instructor either to take the examination at another time prior to the deadline for reporting grades, or request a grade of "Incomplete" be assigned, and must then follow the regulations concerning the removal of the "Incomplete." No exception will be made to these regulations without the written approval of the instructor, the department chair, and the dean of the college in which the course is offered.

- If your CLASS MEETS ANY DAY AT 7 am, your final exam is Saturday, May 16, from 8 to 10 am.
- Classes meeting daily (M-F), four days a week (M-Th), three days a week (MWF), or two days a week (MW, MF, and WF) should follow the MWF schedule.
- Tu or Th ONLY classes follow the TuTh schedule.
- If your CLASS MEETS ONLY ON TUESDAYS from 2 to 5 pm, your exam will be on TUESDAY from 3 to 5 pm.
- If your CLASS MEETS ONLY ON THURSDAYS from 2 to 5 pm, your exam will be on THURSDAY from 3 to 5 pm.
- DAY CLASSES meeting at times other than those above should follow the MWF or TuTh schedule at the hour they regularly meet.
- CLASSES MEETING ONCE WEEKLY will generally take their exams on the day the class normally meets at the time listed in the final exam schedule.
- If your CLASS MEETS ONLY ON FRIDAYS, your exam will be on FRIDAY at the time the class normally meets.

In the event of a **conflict**, the instructor will determine the time or day based on the appropriate MWF or TuTh schedule. If the final exam schedule for your class **does not appear** on this page, contact the academic department offering the course.
