TOP 25 HIGH SCHOOL FEEDERS AT A GLANCE

This report presents a summary of the characteristics of the top 25 high school feeders to CSUN, which contribute about one third of the FTF coming to CSUN.

This report examines the main characteristics of the top 25 high school feeders to CSUN. The report focuses on the diverse academic environments and socio-economic backgrounds of the students revealing disparities among our top 25 feeders.



TOP 25 HIGH SCHOOL FEEDERS: INCOMING FRESHMAN COHORTS: 2014-2018

This report examines general trends for the cohorts that were admitted to CSUN from 2014 to 2018. The analysis focuses on general trends and students' outcomes at CSUN from the top 25 high school feeders. The report reveals better outcomes for those students than the general CSUN population.



TOP 25 HIGH SCHOOL FEEDERS: ANALYSIS OF ACADEMIC PREDICTORS: 2016-2017

CSUN students come from very diverse academic and socio-economic environments. This report examines factors specific to the high school the students come from that may help predict students' academic performance at CSUN.
