






**Title:** **Resolution to Provide more Water Refill Stations across the CSU Northridge Campus**

1. WHEREAS: The Associated Students, Inc. is the official voice of over 38,000 students of California State University, Northridge (CSUN); and
2. WHEREAS: The Associated Students, Inc. is the primary advocate for students at CSUN and provides excellent, meaningful programs and services designed to create and enhance a spirited, learning focused campus environment; and
3. WHEREAS: A goal of the Associated Students, Inc. 2013-2014 Strategic Plan is to increase sustainability efforts on the CSU Northridge campus; and
4. WHEREAS: Upon the recommendation of Environmental Affairs Committee, Associated Students, Inc. funded the installation of water refill stations to existing drinking fountains in eight buildings on CSU Northridge campus; and
5. WHEREAS: These water refill stations have made it easier for students to fill up their water bottles, save money, and decrease the amount of plastic bottles being thrown away; and
6. WHEREAS: These eight refill stations have experienced wide acceptance and a high usage volume by students; and
7. WHEREAS: Additional water refill stations will benefit not only the students/faculty of the campus, but it will also reduce the amount of plastic bottles waste making the campus more eco-friendly; therefore let it be

1. RESOLVED: That the Associated Students, Inc. urges the university to fund the installation of additional water refill stations on drinking fountains across the CSU Northridge campus; let it be further
2. RESOLVED: That the university widely publicize information about the availability of water refill stations on campus as a part of its sustainability efforts, including on the campus website; and let it finally
